

## ORDNANCE ADVISORY I

Waikoloa Village is part of the former Waikoloa Manuever Area / Nansay Combat Range, which closed in 1946. As a result, some areas have the potential to contain unexploded ordnance ( UXO ). An investigation of the site has been performed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. An administrative record has been established and documents related to the investigation are contained in that record which is located at the certain portions of this former defense site. Certain areas may require construction support. Please refer to the administrative record for those specific areas and points of contact.

It is anticipated that a program of construction support shall be instituted as part of the institutional controls for ensuring public health and safety due to the potential presence of UXO within the project area. All such construction support shall be based upon notification to the Project Manager at least 6 months prior to the start of ground disturbing activities. This notification shall include relevant details of the proposed construction including exact location and type of construction activity.
